ORDER

Respondents' motion to dismiss this appeal is granted because the underlying orders are not immediately appealable. *See Townsend v. Townsend*, 323 S.C. 309, 474 S.E.2d 424 (1996) (holding the refusal of a judge to recuse himself is not appealable until final judgment); *Waddell v. Kahdy*, 309 S.C. 1, 419 S.E.2d 783 (1992) (holding an order compelling a party to submit to discovery is interlocutory and not directly appealable).
