

The Record on Appeal served by Appellant is not consecutively numbered.

CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated herein, Respondents move this Court to order Appellant to correct the Record on Appeal by including the items identified above that they designated but which have not been included in the Record. If Appellant does not have in his possession and needs copies of any of the items Respondents have designated, they will be glad to provide them upon request. In addition, Respondents ask that Appellant be ordered to comply with the other requirements set forth in Rule 210, including numbering the Record on Appeal.



I could not sleep so decided to send this email.



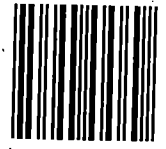
