Your appellee Thomas Raymond Furiols can no longer pay motion fees or other re-lated court costs on a Pauper Income, when appellee did pay court fees they were hard ships, not being able to file necessary motions handicapped appellee and his case before the court and the other Courts Plaintiff was in case with.

This honorable Court Denied in forma Pauperis each time and cited Ex Parte Martin, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.C. 2d 134 (1995) and has been made aware, that there is no Judges Order and supported by a (311) page Court transcript.

The Clerk of Court notified the honorable Judge Robin (B) Stelwell in case No 2016-CP-23-04998 that Plaintiff Thomas Furiols v. the City of Greenville filed into this Court, In Forma Pauperis.

This Court is also aware that Judge Stilwell had no jurisdiction in case no 2016-CP-23-04998 and that the Judge did not address Plaintiff's In forma Pauperis. There is no order. The only order Judge Stilwell issued was to re-mand case no 2016-CP-23-04998 right back to the City of Greenville Municipal Court and to the attention of the honorable Matthew Raymond Gough Day Jr.

This Court is also aware by the Court's memorandum that the Judge's Order to re-mand case back to City of Greenville Court never occurred. It did not happen.

This Court is also aware that several times, Plaintiff Thomas Fuchs in case no 2016-CP-23-04998 filed in Forma Pauperis and that each time into this Court, he filed in Forma Pauperis, this court denied his request to proceed without citing any case law to support each denial to proceed in Forma Pauperis.

In other words, there was no remedy or fundamental right within statutory exception required by constitutional provisions

of Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 3 (c).

Rule 3 (c) also requires waiver of being fees. Judge Stilwell again comes into play and issues his order in another case before him and denial to proceed in forma pauperis. This court is aware that Judge Stilwell and his administrative assistant Ms. Corb and Judge Stilwell law clerk Ms. Wette (Both graces of the Court) filed plaintiffs' motions on his behalf because of ongoing difficulties with clerks of Court and the motion was of crime committed in this case - (F.O.I.A) request denied for information and the murder ruled he remained in Police Custody. This was filed Feb 6<sup>th</sup> 2017.

Judge Stilwell is involved in conflict.

Judge Stilwell was not happy with the Feb 6<sup>th</sup> 2017 filing mentioning him and his staff involvement, filing Plaintiffs' motions.

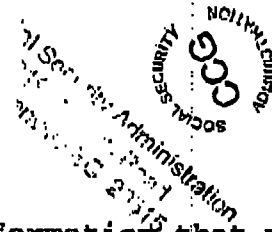
