
Respondent/Appellant's Motion to Substitute Counsel





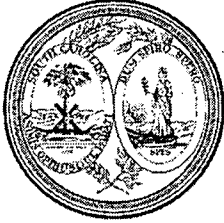
