Respondent respectfully requests the court's assistance in ensuring that the Final Brief of Respondent complies with the court's previous order and Rule 211(b)(1), SCACR.

On July 7th, 2017, the court issued its non-dispositional decision granting Respondent's Motion to Strike Appellant's Amended Designation of Matter and Record on Appeal dated April 12th, 2017 and April 28th, 2017. The court's stated "[t]he record on appeal filed in March shall remain as the record on appeal in this case." Based on this directive, Respondent is preparing its Final Brief of Respondent with references to the Record on Appeal filed by Appellant on March 25th, 2017.

Unfortunately, the March 25th, 2017 Record on Appeal prepared by Appellant *pro se* does not contain consecutively numbered pages as required by Rule 210(c), SCACR. By letter dated March 31st, 2017, the court brought this deficiency to the attention of Appellant and instructed him to correct it. However, to date, Appellant has not done so.

In an effort to ensure that the Final Brief of Respondent complies with Rule 211(b)(1), Respondent would like guidance from the court on how it is to go about referencing the unpaginated Record on Appeal before it prints its Final Brief. Respondent proposes either using the page numbers assigned to the document as it is scanned in C-Track, or allowing Respondent to Bates Stamp the Record and use those page numbers as reference.

I would greatly appreciate any guidance the court can offer. If the court requires this matter be addressed in a Rule 240 Motion, please notify me and I will be happy to oblige.

By copy of this letter to the last known address for Mr. Clarence B. Jenkins, Jr., Claimant *pro se*, I am hereby serving him with a copy of this correspondence with the court.
