
Mr. Shearouse:

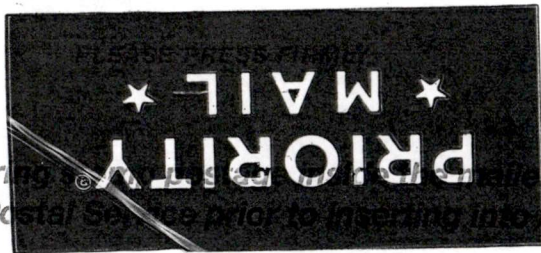
