Dear Mr. Teal:

Upon reviewing your final brief of appellant and attempt to correct the deficiencies listed in this Court's letter dated July 14, 2017 concerning the record on appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The binding does not comply with Rule 267(d), SCACR. The copies of the record on appeal and final brief of appellant need to be bound.
- The bound copies of the final brief of appellant need to have blue covers.
- The record on appeal needs to include all items/documents listed on the designations of matter for both the appellant and respondent, not the actual designation of matter filed by the appellant or respondent and not the summaries of what the items/documents are/contained. See Rule 210(c), SCACR.
- The record on appeal needs to include an index page listing what is included in the record on appeal and the correlating page numbers. See Rule 210(e), SCACR.

- The final brief of appellant should be your initial brief of appellant, as served on February 10, 2017. The final brief of appellant received by the Court on July 25, 2017 is the initial reply brief served on May 3, 2017 and date stamped by the Court on May 5, 2017.
- A proof of service has not been provided showing the attempted corrections and final brief have been served upon the respondent.
