Appellant was compelled to file this motion in response to a letter he received on July 19, 2017 at the institution of F.C.I. Appellant was informed that the above case number had a deficiency, requiring him to ~~file~~ pay a \$100 filing fee, supposedly within ten days of the order.

Appellant asserts that his case should be excluded from a \$100 filing fee, not only because he is indigent, but his assertion can be supported by the (SCACR) rule (203)(B)(iii), "Where criminal appeals will not be required to pay fee, not the S.C. Department of Corrections), Thus appellant ~~case~~ meets the requirements of this court rule.

In conclusion, it is the Respondent's who in fact "contested" the Appellant's prison term. One day prior to his release, therefore Appellant request that he is allowed to file his case in the interest of justice, applicable by the SCACR court rule (203).

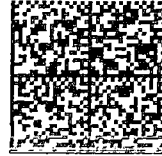
