
INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on April 20, 2017, the Grand Jurors of Lancaster County present upon their oath:

Shoplifting 3rd or Subsequent Property Crime- (Enhancement Per 16-1-57)

That Tina C. Rivers did in Lancaster County, South Carolina, on or about January 30, 2017, take possession of and carry away, transfer from one person to another or from one area of the store or other retail mercantile establishment to another area, or cause the same to be done, merchandise, to wit: various items of merchandise, valued at \$2,000.00 or less, displayed, held, stored, or offered for sale by Wal-Mart with the intention of depriving the merchant of the possession, use, or benefit of the merchandise without paying the full retail value, the defendant having been twice or more previously convicted of a property crime the term of imprisonment for which was contingent upon the value of the property involved, in violation of §16-13-110 and § 16-1-57, *Code of Laws of South Carolina, (1976), as amended.*

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
