NOTICE OF APPEAL

Devanta Boyd appeals the decision of the Honorable H. W. Funderburk, Jr. June 16, 2017. Appellant received a copy of this decision on June 19, 2017.

Appellant Appeal was denied based on the fact that his window being painted which prevents him from looking outside does not create psychological problems, as stated by the ("ALC"). So, therefore the ALC states it does not create a liberty or property interest. This is more than a Amendment 8 violation: cruel and unusual punishment; which I stated in my original grievance. This violation extends far beyond Amendment 8, but also includes a violation

of Amendment 14: Deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law; nor deny any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws. The Institution started a process of painting Inmates' windows and after completing just a portion of the procedure the process was discontinued. Many of us suffered with no access to outside light, which violated equal protection. ACI Administration without any institutional policy about my complaint (painting windows) is a arbitrary and capricious action that created an unequitable and hostile living environment.

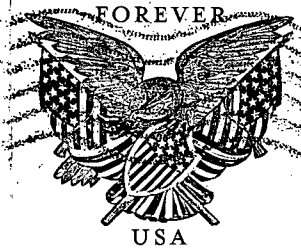
