ORDER

This Court recently dismissed petitioner's notice of appeal of an order denying his fourth application for post-conviction relief. Petitioner was also given notice and an opportunity to provide reasons why this Court should not impose certain restrictions on petitioner's future filings. We find the reasons petitioner provided do not constitute a sufficient basis for not imposing such restrictions. We therefore prohibit petitioner from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court, including PCR actions and habeas corpus actions, as well as any motions relating to the previously filed collateral actions, challenging indictment 1997-GS-40-25414 and the conviction and sentence thereon, or any motions in the underlying criminal case, including a motion pursuant to Rule 29, SCRCrimP, without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court.
