Statement of Judgment by the Court:

Defendant's civil appeal from Magistrate's Court, filed June 7, 2016, came before the Court on June 28, 2017. "Section 18-7-170 of the South Carolina Code (1985) articulates the standard of review to be applied by the Circuit Court in an appeal of a magistrate's judgment: Upon hearing the appeal, the appellate court shall give judgment according to the justice of the case, without regard to technical errors and defects which do not affect the merits. In giving judgment, the court may affirm or reverse the judgment of the court below, in whole or in part, as to any or all the parties and for errors of law or fact." Bowers v. Thomas, 373 S.C. 240, 244, 644 S.E.2d 751, 753 (Ct. App. 2007). The Court, having found adequate evidentiary support in the record, no error of law, and finding no abuse of discretion, AFFIRMS the decision of the lower court.
