

1. The Ordered Transcript from the April 20, 2017 Hearing of the York County Court of Common Pleas Master in Equity hearing from which Appellant takes their appeal was ordered on May 31, 2017.
2. The Ordered Transcript was delivered to the Offices of Counsel for Appellant on July 5, 2017.
3. Pursuant to the scheduling requirements of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Counsel for Appellant believes that the deadline to file the initial appellate brief and record on appeal is August 4, 2017.
4. Counsel for Appellant was on secured leave last week as well as preparing for other matters including pending depositions and mediation and required submittals for the same occurring in New Hampshire the week of August 7, 2017 in which Counsel for Appellant is appearing Pro Hac Vice. In additional, Counsel for Appellant has been working with Appellant's personal counsel in this matter to gather the necessary documentation for the Record on Appeal and necessary information for the Initial Brief.
