

ORDER

First, Appellant's motion for an enlargement of time to provide a proof of service for his motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is granted. After careful consideration of the motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*, it is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Second, Appellant's motion to order the transcript outside the time provided in the appellate court rules is granted. Within fifteen days of the date of this order, Appellant shall provide proof he has made satisfactory arrangements with the court reporter for furnishing the transcript.
