Ms. Toal:

It is my sincere hopes that contacting you will not only resolve the issues that I have had with the Court of Appeals, but it will also result in disciplinary action to those involved. It Is also my sincere hopes that you actually respond to me. If need be, I have no problem bringing attention to this matter through other available sources.

On or around April 15, 2015, I called to check on the status of an appeal that I had filed. I had done this on numerous other occasions, and had been informed that no one has had the opportunity to review my filing. I was also informed that the judges do not have a fixed amount of time in which they must review an individual's filings, and respond to them.

However, on this occasion when I called, I was informed that my filings could not be found. In addition, I was informed that the filings of Dameon Myers could not be found. Immediately, I questioned how this can happen, and inquired as to whom is responsible for documents filed with the court of appeals. I also asked her whom do I contact to file a complaint. I was intentionally misinformed that there is no one over the clerk's office.

This very same woman attempted numerous times to get off the phone with me by transferring me to someone else. **But, after realizing that she was in no way helpful, or concerned about the fact that the South Carolina Court of Appeals Clerk's Office had just lost two different set of appeals documents,** I agreed to be transferred to Jacqueline Oret (spelling may be different), whom she stated was the individual **assigned to my case.** After being transferred to Ms. Oret's voice mail and leaving a message on her voicemail, I then waited to receive a phone call with an explanation. That never happened.

So, I later called back and spoke with another clerk. She informed me that Ms. Kitchings had informed her to personally obtain my contact information and she, Ms. Kitchings, will be getting

back with me. Instead of receiving a phone call, Ms. Kitchings mailed out two letter to me in one envelope. One letter apologized for the "delay"; the other informed me to advise the court of the status of the transcript within ten days or my appeal may be dismissed. The letter was dated April 16. 2015.

This correspondence arrived on the weekend, so I was forced to wait until Monday to attempt to make contact with Ms. Oret or Ms. Kitchings. I finally di speak with Ms. Oret, and inquired a to my "Informa Pauperis" documents. She could not answer me. Which tells me that not only had I been constructively hindered and obstructed for over six months; my original documents may also have been compromised, altered, and/or destroyed.

It is my sincere hopes that you can explain to me how the Clerk of Court's Office ca tamper with documents filed with the court of appeals.

It is my sincere hopes that you can explain to me how I can be hindered and delayed for over six months and then threatened by way of a letter, to perform an act within ten days, or face dismissal of my appeal.

It is my hopes that you can explain to me how my appeal and Dameon Myers's appeal was "lost" after being received by the clerk's office in the court of appeal.


This is not the first time that the court of appeals have responded back in a manner which is questionable at least, and not consistent with proper due process procedures.



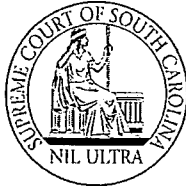


