





This matter comes before the Court by way of an application for post-conviction relief filed March 8, 2017.


I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Applicant is presently confined in the South Carolina Department of Corrections pursuant to orders of commitment of the York County Clerk of Court. Applicant was indicted at the November 2011 term of the York County Grand Jury for Burglary, 1st Degree (2011-GS-46-3701). B.J. Barrowclough, Esquire, represented him. On March 22, 2012, Applicant pled guilty but mentally ill to Burglary, 1st Degree. The Honorable Michael G. Nettles sentenced him to confinement for fifteen years. Applicant did not appeal his conviction or sentence.

2013-CP-46-2174

Applicant subsequently filed for post-conviction relief on July 18, 2013. In his application, Applicant asserted claims of ineffective assistance of counsel. Respondent filed its Return and an evidentiary hearing was held in York County on December 10, 2013. Applicant was present and represented by W. Michael Hemlepp, Esquire. J. Rutledge Johnson, Esquire, represented Respondent. By an Order signed on December 11, 2013, and filed December 12,

2013, the Honorable John C. Hayes, III, denied and dismissed the application with prejudice. Applicant did not appeal.

In his second application for post-conviction relief the Applicant alleged that he was being held in custody unlawfully for the following reasons:

1. Ineffective Assistance of PCR Counsel
 - a. "State appointed PCR counsel did not file a Notice of Appeal, appealing the PCR Court's order of denial (2013-CP-46-2174) case."


Respondent made its Return on or about August 12, 2015, requesting an evidentiary hearing solely on the issue of whether Applicant was entitled to an appellate review of his first post-conviction relief action pursuant to Austin. An evidentiary hearing on the matter was convened on January 19, 2016, at the Moss Justice Center in York, South Carolina. Prior to the start of the evidentiary hearing, the State indicated to this Court that it would be consenting to the grant of an Austin appeal. Respondent explained that the State was consenting based off of its discussions with prior PCR Counsel and discussion with Applicant's current PCR Counsel. By an order signed January 19, 2016 and filed January 21, 2016, the Honorable Paul Burch granted Applicant an appeal of 2013-CP-46-2174 pursuant to Austin v. State.

Current Application

In Applicant's current PCR application, he alleges that his PCR counsel in 2015-CP-46-1169 missed the filing deadline to file the notice of appeal pursuant to Austin v. State that was granted on January 19, 2016.

II. FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Applicant alleges that he was denied the right to appeal the dismissal of his first post-conviction relief application. Pursuant to Austin, a post-conviction relief applicant may petition



the South Carolina Supreme Court for discretionary review of the dismissal of his prior application. Respondent has indicated to this Court that it consented to the grant of an Austin appeal. Respondent explained that it was consenting based off of its discussions with prior PCR Counsel and discussion with Applicant's current PCR Counsel.


After review of the facts and circumstances surrounding the waiver of Applicant's right to appeal the denial of his post-conviction relief application, this Court finds that Applicant is entitled to appeal the denial of his first post-conviction relief application (2013-CP-46-2174) pursuant to Austin v. State. This Court finds that Applicant did not voluntarily waive his right to appeal the post-conviction relief court's denial and dismissal of his prior post-conviction relief action.

Based upon the foregoing, this Court finds that the granting of an appeal of Applicant's first post-conviction relief action (2013-CP-46-2174) pursuant to Austin v. State is warranted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Applicant be granted an appeal of case 2013-CP-46-2174 pursuant to Austin v. State; and
2. That Applicant remain in the custody of the South Carolina Department of Corrections.
