With apologies to the Court, Appellant, the South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce, hereby requests that this Court's Order of August 3, 2017 be amended slightly to accommodate a clerical error by undersigned counsel in connection with the original Motion to Hold in Abeyance, etc., filed on June 13,

2107. Undersigned counsel for the Defendant has consulted with Dan Williams, counsel for Plaintiffs-Respondents, who, without waiving any other rights, consents to the present motion.


In that June 13, 2017 motion to this Court, undersigned counsel referred to the April 28, 2017 Rule 59 motion filed by DEW, but inadvertently did not mention an amended Rule 59(e) motion which had been filed by DEW on May 1, 2017, the next business day, and still well within the time for filing a Rule 59(e) motion. The amended motion was the same in substance as the original, except that it clarified the relief sought by the motion.

This Court's Order of August 3, 2017, partially remanded the case "for the limited purpose of allowing the circuit court to rule on the pending Rule 59(e) motion."

In order to ensure that the circuit court will also have authority on remand to consider the amended motion, undersigned counsel requests that this Court modify the language above by adding "as amended," so that the Order will read, "for the limited purpose of allowing the circuit court to rule on the pending Rule 59(e) motion as amended."

Again, undersigned counsel apologizes to the Court for the need to bring this matter to the Court's attention once more.




