In Respondents' Exhibit C: Appellant addressed the bias and prejudice of the Commission to allowed Respondents to present information that he was not given the same opportunity without a contentious debate p.69 lines 10-25 of May 21, 2015 transcript.

The actions of the South Carolina Worker's Compensation Commission on May 21, 2015 was biased and prejudiced therefore seen as such by Appellant.



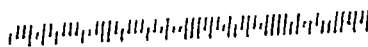
