
MOTION FOR EXTENSION



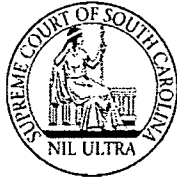
