**Summary of Argument**

Triando Stroud had his children over the weekend and Sunday Shaquita Frazier and Triando Stroud had an agreement to meet on Brookshire Blvd at a store since Shaquita worked off Tyvola Rd. Shaquita worked 2<sup>nd</sup> shift and got off at 9pm and wanted to meet at Mcdonald's off Tyvola Rd. in Charlotte, Nc. Triando and Shaquita met at that location numerous of times since Triando live in Concord Nc as a half way meeting destination. The agreement failed because Shaquita said if Triando can't meet her on Tyvola figure it out. Sunday March 8, 2015 around 10pm Triando decided to take the kids home because Kirstin Stroud at age 6 was had school the next morning and Kamerin Frazier at the time was 1 years old. Triando headed to South Carolina from North Carolina with his 2 children , his girlfriend Nakiesha Barnette, and her son Jakobe McCall. At arrival Triando took the kids to the door and Shaquita came to the door. Triando went back to the car and got the bags out the car and when Triando asked Shaquita why we couldn't meet in Charlotte, Nc knowing Kirstin had school the mom Patricia Brown jumped off the couch assuming it was more than what it was and got between Triando and Shaquita in Triando face giving Triando no option but to her away from him and as soon as that happen Shaquita struck Triando outside because Patricia, Shaquita, and Triando was at the doorstep and Shaquita was trying to fight Triando and Nakiesha and Jakobe got out the car to break everything up and Alvania came outside stating she about to call the police not knowing what just happened. Triando, Nakiesha, and Jakobe went back to Concord, Nc. A few days later Triando received a phone call Thursday March 12, 2015 from officer saying he need to turn himself in because he has a warrant and Triando turned himself the next day March 13<sup>th</sup> , 2015 early in the morning.

## Statement of Material Facts

Triando Stroud has a copy of the report and Officer Matthew Beach stating he could not find no visible manifestation of injury or dirt or mud stains from being thrown to the ground on any of the victims. They both checked by EMS, but refused to be transported to the hospital. EMS did not find any physical manifestation of injury either.

- B. Petitioner's gun was taken after court

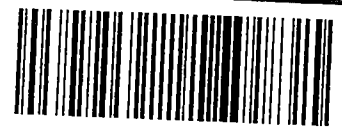

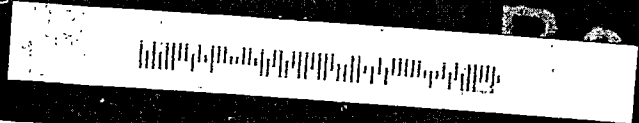

On 3/9/2015 Officers Beach and Price of the Rock Hill Police Department responded to 2743 Round Hill Ct within the city limits of Rock Hill SC in reference to a domestic violence situation. Upon arrival, victim

came out of the house crying and speaking loudly and angrily about Triando Stroud, the father of her children, striking her, her sister, and her mother. Officer Beach calmed and learned that Stroud had already left the scene in a white Audi (Tag Unk). Officer Beach then identified sister, and their mother, as victims in an assault by Triando and his girlfriend, (DOB Unk).

stated she had tried to arrange a meeting with Stroud to exchange their children, but they disputed over a good location and finally told Stroud she was going to go home and he would have to bring the children to her if he wanted to drop them off. stated Stroud brought along and all three of them exchanged heated words while the children were dropped off. stated the situation escalated and Stroud began to get into her face, so physically placed herself between and Stroud. stated Stroud pushed her out of the way and knocked her to the floor before striking

in the face with his closed fist. stated the fight then moved out of the house to the front yard where Stroud again knocked to the ground. stated she came out to try and break up the fight, but pushed her back warning her not to call police. stated Stroud and then began to move toward their car with Stroud stating, "I should shoot all of you." also claimed that Stroud told to, "get the gun." stated Stroud and entered their vehicle and left the area without displaying a firearm. EMS responded regarding complaints of severe head pain. Officer Beach could find no visible manifestation of injury or dirt or mud stains from being thrown to the ground on any of the victims. and were both checked by EMS, but refused to be transported to the hospital. EMS did not find any physical manifestation of injury either. Officer Beach will follow up with the victims as well as the suspect in regards to possible charges.
