## ORDER

Appellant is attempting to appeal a letter from the Clerk of the Administrative Law Court explaining that Appellant's appeal would not be processed. Because the letter is not a final order from an administrative law judge, this appeal is dismissed. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 14-8-200 (2017) (providing that this court has jurisdiction over any case in which an appeal is taken from an order, judgment, or decree of the circuit court, family court, a final decision of an agency, a final decision of an administrative law judge, or the final decision of the Workers' Compensation Commission); Rule 201(a), SCACR ("Appeal may be taken, as provided by law from any final judgment, appealable order or decision."). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
