Dear Mr. Stroud:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title should read as follows:

City of Rock Hill, Respondent,

v.

Triando Stroud, Appellant.

- Your initial brief of appellant must be properly paginated.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. The designation of matter should contain a table of contents with page references.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in the Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR. Your proof of service must show that you have served a copy of your initial brief and designation of matter on Anna Thomas, counsel for the respondent.

The initial brief of appellant should contain the following as set forth in Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR:

- (A) Table of Contents and Cases
- (B) Statement of Issues on Appeal
- (C) Statement of the Case
- (D) Argument
- (E) Conclusion

A more detailed explanation of what is to be included in your brief can be found in Rule 208 of the SCACR.
