
I represent the Respondent, Federal Mogul Corporation, in the above referenced matter.

As to the Appellant's Designation of Matter, I respectfully question the inclusion of Number 27 (Deposition of Dr. David C. Gaines) and Number 24 (as it pertains to the April 17, 2008 Deposition of the Claimant). I can find no indication that either of these depositions were made a part of the Commission's record. 


