MOTION TO FILE
SUPPLEMENTAL APPENDIX

Counsel for Dion O. Taylor seeks to supplement the appendix pursuant to Rule 243(f), SCACR. In support of this motion counsel shows:

1. On November 24, 2015, prior counsel for Petitioner served and filed a petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to Johnson v. State, 294 S.C. 310, 364 S.E.2d 201 (1988), a motion to be relieved as counsel, and an accompanying appendix.
2. On March 24, 2017, this Court denied the motion to be relieved as counsel and directed Petitioner to serve and file a petition addressing the question specified in the order.
3. On May 11, 2017, undersigned counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari with this Court.

4. Yesterday, August 23, 2017, counsel for Respondent notified undersigned counsel that the appendix originally filed on November 24, 2015 does not include all the attachments to the return and motion to dismiss filed with the Charleston County Clerk of Court on April 3, 2014. These attachments were inadvertently not included in the appendix filed with this Court.



Therefore, inasmuch as Rule 243(f)(1), SCACR, requires a copy of the entire lower court record be included in the appendix, counsel requests leave to file a supplemental appendix containing a complete copy of the return and motion to dismiss filed with the Charleston County Clerk of Court on April 3, 2014.

6. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

7. The supplemental appendix is being filed simultaneously with this motion.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel respectfully requests this Court to allow the appendix to be supplemented to include a complete copy of the return and motion to dismiss based on the above circumstances.




