This matter was not dismissed by the Court of Appeals for procedural or other reasons. The court found that the appellant failed to cure the deficiencies contained in the Second Record on Appeal. The court found no basis for granting the petition to reinstate. The court did not act on Respondent's "motion to dismiss the appeal and dismiss Appellant's petition to reinstate the appeal."


The Petitioner request the Supreme Court's discretion or power to grant review in general, the character of reasons which will be considered in **RULE 242(b)(2)**

There is a dissent in the decision of the Court of Appeals that caused the Appellant a great injustice and the reason for the request for writ of certiorari:

1. The Appellant has provided Second Amended Record on Appeal to the Court of Appeals and to the Respondent and an additional Supplemental Record on Appeal with all requested information.
2. The Respondent continues to request the same information over again. The respondent's claim that the document submitted by Appellant in the Record on Appeal to request a refund is of unknown origin and is not a part of the Horry County file. The Horry County Board of Assessment Appeals clearly states in the heading **Refund Appeal** on second request for an appeal. The Respondent's claim of unknown documents are the result of poor record keeping of the Horry County Assessor's Office.
3. The Appellant's first request for an appeal and the Appellants Attorney's request for appeal were both unrecognized in the files of the Assessor and resulted in no actions of the Horry County
4. Assessor's office. The Respondent did not provide a response to request for a conference as stated in statue of law for appeal with the Horry County Appeal Board.
5. The Respondent's second claim of omission in the Record on Appeal by the Appellant is a letter that was requested and submitted to the Respondent multiple times. The letter ended with no additional comments. The respondent claims that the letter explained statue of law of Horry

County Assessors and reasons of charging the Appellant over \$30,000 for property taxes for two years and on the next year and future years charged less than \$500 for property tax on the same property. According to the Respondent the letter explained the South Carolina Rule of law that provided no refund for errors on overage in assessment.

The respondent claim that the omission of these two documents were grounds for dismissal because the Respondent alleged that the Petitioner failed to cure the deficiencies in the Record on Appeal. The Petitioner has submitted a Second Amended Record on Appeal and Supplemental Record on Appeal with the documents attached as requested by the court. The Petitioner pray that the South Carolina Supreme Court will review the documents and rule on the merits of the case.


