## ORDER

On March 31, 2017, this court denied Appellant's request to proceed without costs and ordered Appellant to pay the filing fee and serve the record on appeal within twenty days. Appellant subsequently filed a motion for an extension. On June 7, 2017, this court granted Appellant's motion for an extension, ordering Appellant to pay the filing fee and serve the record on appeal within twenty days. This court explained that no further extensions would be granted absent extraordinary circumstances.

Appellant has now filed a motion to waive the filing fee and a request for another extension. This court declines to reconsider our order denying Appellant's request to proceed without costs. *See* Rule 240(i), SCACR. Further, Appellant's request for an extension is denied because Appellant has failed to show extraordinary circumstances. Unless Appellant pays the \$100 filing fee and provides proof that he has served the record on appeal on Respondent within ten days, this appeal will be dismissed.
