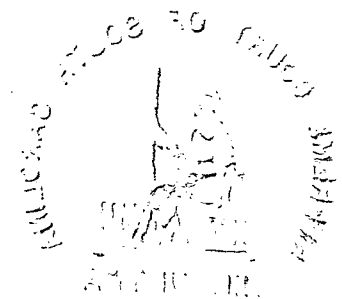
ORDER





ORDER


