**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO SERVE AND FILE RETURN AND REPLY
TO THE MOTION FOR COSTS
OF DAUFUSKIE ISLAND UTILITY COMPANY, INC.**

Pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rule 263(b) and 240(e) the Appellants and Respondents jointly move for an extension of ten days, to file a return to the motion for costs and an extension of five days to file a reply to the return. 


