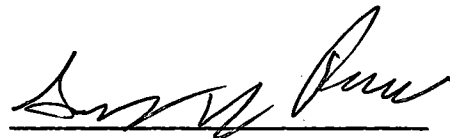
MEMORANDUM

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.



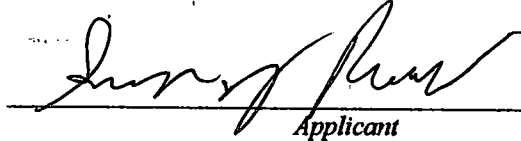

- (2) Because of my poverty I am unable to pay the costs of said proceeding or give security thereof.

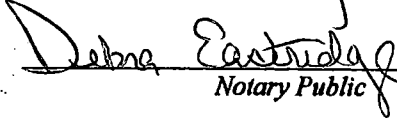
