MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE RETURN TO PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI

Counsel for Therron R. Richardson respectfully requests an extension of thirty days in which to file the return to the petition for writ of certiorari in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:


1. The return to the petition for writ of certiorari is due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Therron R. Richardson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. On July 24, 2017, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Romeo Brown v. The State with this Court. On July 20, 2017, counsel filed the petition for rehearing in State v. Wayland Purnell with the Court of Appeals. On July 13, 2017, counsel filed the petition for rehearing in In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Carl M. Asquith with the Court of Appeals. On July 12, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Justin Antonio Butler with the Court of Appeals. On July 7, 2017, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Joseph Walker v. The State with this Court. On July 5, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Nelson H. Castro with the Court of Appeals. On June 29, 2017, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Holly Earlene Mahon with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.






