**SHOPLIFTING**

Further, that the Defendant has at least (2) two or more prior convictions for offenses for which the term of imprisonment is contingent upon the value of the property involved, all in violation of §16-13-0110 (B)(1); §16-1-57, THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976), as amended.
