Expedited or Emergency Motion

I Appellant is compelled to file this motion under the S.C. rules of court rule (2-101). I request a favorable ruling in regards to this motion because I am suffering unceremonial harm by the government of S.C., being that the Dept arbitrarily forfeited my Sept 1, 2017 one day prior to my expected freedom.

My release was forfeited due to a "forced" interpretation of provision 44-53-370 by "private" Dept staff members. 14th Amendment errors have been neglected here, the Dept held a "due process" hearing two weeks after my release date. The APA act states' conducted matters should afford (30) days notice.

I have been illegally in custody over this "forced punishment" for over a year, waiting for this action of government to be corrected. The Appellant must also inform the court that other offenders of 44-53-370 (b)(2) have been "pre-maturely" released and have not been reapprehended by any state Agency, while I wait on the slow wheels of justice. The Dept has kept records to prove I should be free and am a victim of wrongful action. The Dept is in violation of 18. U.S code 3601 (a) (1).

Appellate request the court take notice of the urgency and order the most effective and immediate relief possible.
