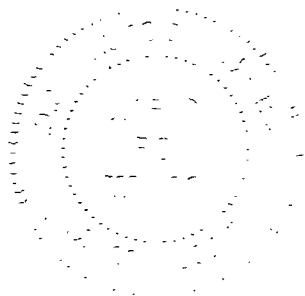

INDICTMENT FOR  
BURGLARY FIRST DEGREE AND GRAND LARCENY

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on **FEB 21 2017** the Grand Jurors of Greenville  
County present upon their oath:

**COUNT I – BURGLARY FIRST DEGREE**

That CHRISTIAN ARENSON SCOWCROFT did in Greenville County, on or about the 16th day of August 2016, willfully and unlawfully enter the dwelling of HARRISON GOLSON located at [redacted] Court, Greenville, SC, without consent and with the intent to commit a crime therein, and the burglary was accompanied by circumstances of aggravation, to wit: defendant did become armed with a deadly weapon upon entering the dwelling. This is in violation of §16-11-0311 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

**COUNT II – GRAND LARCENY**

That CHRISTIAN ARENSON SCOWCROFT did in Greenville County, on or about the 16th day of August, 2016, feloniously take and carry away the personal property of HARRISON GOLSON to wit: a shotgun, rifle and scope, gaming system with games and controllers, with a total value of more than Two Thousand Dollars with the intent to deprive the owner permanently of such property. This is in violation of §16-13-0030 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
