Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Janoblin Maurice Bracey-Brown with the Court of Appeals on May 8, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Gregory Allan Ivery v. State with the Supreme Court on April 24, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in Christopher Poage v. State with the Supreme Court on April 24, 2017.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




