MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Dajlia Symone Torbit in the Court of Appeals on August 11, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Taquan Brown with the Court of Appeals on August 10, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Daniel Caleb Braxton in the Court of Appeals on August 4, 2017. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of The State v. Theia Darion McArdle in the Court of Appeals on August 2, 2017. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Jo Pradubsri in the Court of Appeals on July 25, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Herbie Val Singleton, Jr. in the Court of Appeals on July 19, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Ontario Stefon Patrick Makins in the Court of Appeals on July 14, 2017. Counsel filed the return to the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Alexander Carmichael Huckabee, III in the Supreme Court on July 11, 2017.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


