

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Herbie Val Singleton, Jr. in the Court of Appeals on July 19, 2017. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Ontario Stefon Patrick Makins in the Court of Appeals on July 14, 2017. 3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will


hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




