Dear Counsel:

This is the second letter from this Court attempting to cure the following deficiencies. On March 20, 2017, the Court received a *pro se* notice of appeal from Mr. Coon. According to the public index search you were the most recent counsel for Mr. Coon, and we believe that the notice of appeal that was received may be trying to appeal his conviction and sentence imposed on January 12, 2017. Pursuant to Rule 264(a), SCACR, you are considered counsel of record until a motion to be relieved is granted by this Court, or until the Office of Appellate Defense screens the case.

Within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, you must provide the Court with the following:

- (1) A notice of appeal containing all information required in Rule 203, SCACR.
- (2) Proof of service naming the documents served and showing you timely served all parties to the appeal.
- (3) A copy of the court order being challenged on appeal.

Failure to provide the requested items will result in dismissal of the appeal.
