21 where you live, in Neeses?

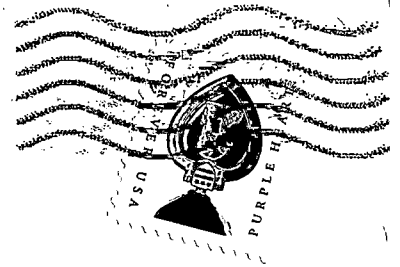
