Dear Mr. Faubel:

Upon reviewing your Brief of Appellant, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. The Court cannot accept your initial brief until the designation of matter is also served and filed. See Rule 209, SCACR, for guidance. The respondent's initial brief and designation of matter will be due 30 days from the date of service of the appellant's designation of matter.
- The content of your brief is single spaced. You must serve and file an amended brief in which the type is double spaced, pursuant to Rule 208, SCACR.
- Because the designation of matter was not served and filed with your initial brief, it is now late. You must serve and file a motion asking the Court to accept the service and filing of your designation of matter out of time. Your motion must be in compliance with Rule 240, SCACR, or it will not be considered by this Court.
