
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On June 14, 2016, Appellant's counsel wrote the Court and pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR, cited the Court's then-recent decision in *Marshall v. Dodds*, Op. No. 5403 (S.C. Ct. App. filed May 4, 2016), as supplemental authority in support of Appellant's position in the above-referenced matter. Thereafter, on June 16, 2016, counsel for Respondent MUSC wrote the Court in response, disputing the pertinence and significance of *Marshall* in respect of the issues involved in the instant appeal. While to be clear, Respondent Roberts, too, denies that the *Marshall* decision is dispositive of this appeal in any event, Respondent Roberts believes it is appropriate under the circumstances to point out that the Supreme Court has recently granted cert in *Marshall*; a copy of the Court's order filed August 22, 2017, granting the petitions for writs of certiorari is attached. 

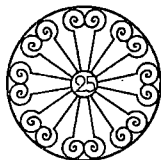
