
ORDER

By order dated September 5, 2017, this Court denied the petition for rehearing in this case. Pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the Clerk of this Court properly sent the remittitur to the Workers' Compensation Commission (Commission) that same day.

Petitioner has now filed a motion to stay the remittitur and for a hearing before this Court.
