
Dear Mr. Shearouse:

This letter replies to Mr. Henry's December 3, 2012 response to our November 29, 2012 supplemental citation letter. Mr. Henry is incorrect in his assertion that "amalgamation" is separate and distinct from the *remedy* of piercing the corporate veil and the *theories or rationales*, such as alter ego, that allow for the imposition of that remedy. See Drury Dev. Corp. v. Foundation Ins. Co., 380 S.C. 97, 101, 668 S.E.2d 798, 800 (2008) (explaining that the "alter ego" doctrine is merely a theory or means of obtaining the procedural relief of piercing the corporate veil). Thus, the case of Oskin v. Johnson, Op. No. 27187 (S.C. Sup. Ct. filed Nov. 7, 2012) (Shearouse Adv. Sh. No. 40 at 67) is pertinent to the arguments set forth in Section I (pp. 5-10) of the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari, and in Section I (pp. 1-4) of the Reply in Support of the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari.
