
The Court received your emails on September 18, 2017, and September 20, 2017, which were not copied on opposing counsel. Also, it was again copied to Chief Judge Lockemy. As stated in our October 26, 2016 letter, all correspondence in this case must be addressed to the Clerk of Court and not to the Chief Judge. Chief Judge Lockemy cannot respond to your ex parte communication.

We emailed the Court's August 24, 2017 order to you to be certain you received the order. However, we will no longer accept any filings from you via email. If you wish to request relief from this court, you must do so by filing a motion pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) accompanied by a proof of service upon all parties utilizing the U.S Mail as contemplated by Rule 262, SCACR.

In response to your questions, your appellant's initial brief and designation of matter are due to be served and filed no later than September 25, 2017, as set forth in the Court's order dated August 24, 2017.

Regarding e-filing, our court has not implemented e-filing. All filings with this court are made as set forth in Rule 262, SCACR. Regarding receipt of filings from opposing counsel, the requirements of Rule 262 apply equally to opposing counsel's filings as they do to you. Finally, regarding the times for responding to different respondents' initial briefs, our timelines show that you have ten days from service of the latest-filed respondent's initial brief to file your initial reply brief if that is your desire. For reference, see Rule 208(a)(3), SCACR.
