**IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:**  See attached order (formal order to follow)  Statement of Judgment by the Court: Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment on all claims, filed 12/9/16, is granted. Defendant has demonstrated that there is no genuine issue of material fact. Plaintiff's claims for false arrest, false imprisonment, and unlawful search and seizure must fail as no private cause of action exists for these claims. Plaintiff's cause of action for gross negligence must fail, as evidence of "slight care" is present. The Defendant enjoys immunity under the SC Tort Claims Act, S.C. Code 15-78-60, from intentional torts, losses resulting from discretionary judgment of a government employee, and punitive damages. No evidence of malice has been presented to support a malicious prosecution claim. No evidence to support a claim for negligent hiring, training, or supervision has been presented. The Plaintiff has voluntarily withdrawn his claim for intentional infliction of emotional distress.
