
I need the above motions heard because they affect the law of the case and because they intertwine with my wrongfull conviction which is currently under appeal (2015-000884).

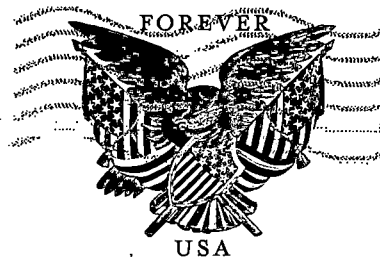
