



Thank you for your time and consideration in this matter.



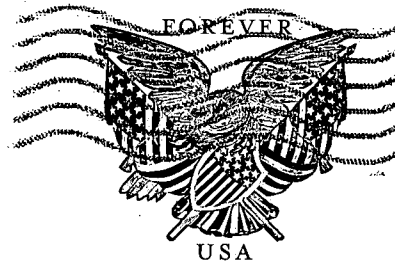
