The Court is in receipt of your material, filed September 13, 2017, which we are construing to be a notice of appeal of civil action case number 2017-CP-28-00131. Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service must comply with the form of papers under Rule 267, SCACR. It must be headed with a caption and include the case name and correct case number.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- You must provide proof that you have filed your notice of appeal with the lower court clerk of court.
