


This extension is based on a medical issue whereby I am scheduled for Back Surgery that week and will be out due to recovery of surgery due to deteriorating discs.

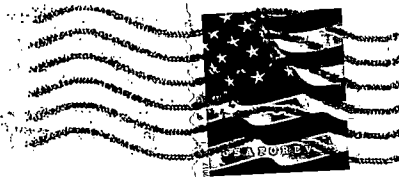
