


The ALC has jurisdiction over all properly perfected inmate appeals but, “[s]ummary dismissal may be appropriate where the inmate’s grievance does not implicate a state-created liberty or property interest.” Slezak v. S.C. Dept. of Corrs., 361 S.C. 327, 605 S.E.2d 506 (2004). The right implicated by wrongful conviction or imprisonment is not a state-created liberty interest, such as this Court has jurisdiction over. Therefore, it is appropriate to dismiss this case.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Department’s Motion to Dismiss is **GRANTED** and this appeal is **DISMISSED**.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
