

ORDER

The appellant was sentenced on September 15, 2017. Pursuant to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), the notice of appeal must be served within ten days after the sentence is imposed. Thus, by calculation under Rule 263, SCACR, the notice of appeal must have been served on the State no later than September 25, 2017. The proof of service of the notice of appeal indicates it was served September 29, 2017. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed for failure to timely serve the notice of appeal. *State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 119, 784 S.E.2d 690, 692 (Ct. App. 2016) (noting the time for service of a notice of appeal is a jurisdictional requirement that may not be extended by the appellate court.) The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
